Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Christ has risen, Alleluia. He has risen indeed. Alleluia. As we gather on this joyous day to celebrate the 7th Sunday of Easter, we unite today's gospel with the Feast of the Ascension of Our Lord,

and we are reminded of the profound mystery of Christ's departure from the earth and His glorious return to the Father. In the Gospel this week, we hear Jesus' prayer to the Father, in which He speaks of His impending departure from the world. He says, "And now I am no longer in the world, but they are in the world, and I am coming to you. Holy Father, protect them in your name that you have given me, so that they may be one, as we are one" (John 17:11). These words of Jesus reveal His deep concern for His disciples, whom He is leaving behind to continue His mission in the world. He entrusts them to the Father's care, praying for their protection and unity in His absence. Even as He prepares to depart from them physically, He assures them of His abiding presence and love. The Ascension marks the culmination of Jesus' earthly ministry and the beginning of a new chapter in the life of the Church. As Jesus ascends to heaven, He takes His rightful place at the right hand of the Father, from where He continues to intercede for us and to pour out His blessings upon His people. But He also entrusts to us the task of continuing His work on earth, proclaiming the Gospel to all nations and making disciples of all peoples. In His prayer, Jesus speaks to the disciples as being, "in the world", but not, "of the world" (John 17:11). As followers of Christ, we are called to be in the world, actively engaged in the affairs of this life, yet always mindful of our heavenly citizenship and our ultimate destiny.

We are called to be salt and light in the world, bringing the flavor of Christ's love and the brightness of His truth to all whom we encounter. My dear friends, as we reflect on the mystery of the Ascension today, let us renew our commitment to being faithful disciples of Jesus Christ. Let us take up the task that Christ has entrusted to us with courage and zeal, knowing that He is with us always, even to the end of the age. And may we, like the disciples before us, be united in our love for one another and in our devotion to our risen and ascended Lord.

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

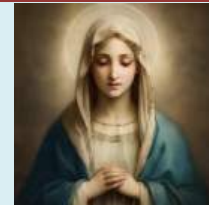
Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

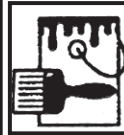

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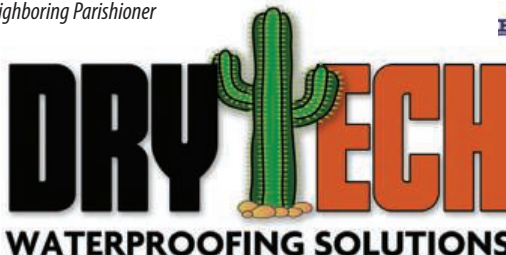
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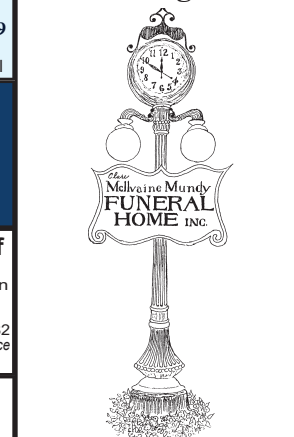
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
