Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today, we celebrate the great Solemnity of Pentecost, the day when the Holy Spirit descended upon the apostles, empowering them to proclaim the Gospel to all nations. It is a day of immense significance in the life of the Church, marking the birth of her mission and the outpouring of God's love upon His people. As we reflect on the events of that first Pentecost, we are reminded of the transformative power of the Holy Spirit. The apostles, who were once timid and fearful, were filled with courage and zeal to boldly proclaim the message of Jesus Christ. May God bless you all abundantly on this Feast of Pentecost, and may the Holy Spirit continue to guide and inspire you in all that you do. Baptism

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.
