



Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today we gather to celebrate the Solemnity of the Holy Trinity, the central mystery of our Catholic faith. This profound mystery reveals God as three Divine Persons in one essence; the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. The Trinity is not merely a doctrine to be understood but a reality to be lived. It is the mystery of God's very nature – one God in three distinct Divine Persons, bound together in a perfect relationship of love. This dynamic of love is the source of all creation and the foundation of our faith. Each Divine Person of the Trinity plays a unique role in our salvation history; the Father as Creator, the Son as Redeemer, and the Holy Spirit as Sanctifier. Today is the feast day of our patron St. Philip Neri. To help us delve into this mystery, we look to the life of St. Philip who embodied the joy and love of the Trinity in a remarkable way. St. Philip, known as the "Apostle of Rome", lived in the 16th century. His life was a testament to the transformative power of God's love. St. Philip was renowned for his charity, humility and joyful spirit, his deep prayer life, and his profound love for others. These qualities made him an exemplary witness to the life of the Trinity. St. Philip's joy was contagious. He believed that a Christian should radiate the joy of the Gospel. This joy is a reflection of the love shared among the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. Just as the Trinity is a communion of love, St. Philip's joy drew people into a deeper relationship with God and with each other. His playful humor and genuine happiness were not superficial but rooted in a profound experience of God's love. St. Philip spent hours in prayer, often entering into mystical experiences where he felt enveloped by God's presence. His prayer life was a direct communion with the Trinity, drawing strength and inspiration from each Divine Person. Through prayer, St. Philip deepened his relationship with the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit, allowing their love to flow through him to others. St. Philip had a deep love of our Blessed Mother and encouraged others to entrust their life to Our Lady. St. Philip's love for God naturally extended to his love for his neighbor. He found the Oratory, a congregation dedicated to the spiritual formation of the laity. His ministry focused on personal interaction, confession, and spiritual guidance, emphasizing that the love of the Trinity must be made manifest in acts of charity and service. St. Philip's life was a living example of how divine love within the Trinity can overflow into the world, transforming lives and communities.

As we celebrate the Solemnity, let us remember that this mystery is not just an abstract concept but a living reality. Like St. Philip, we are called to live in the joy of the Gospel, deepen our prayer life, and extend God's love to others. By doing so, we participate in the life of the Trinity, allowing God's love to transform us and flow through us to the world, in the spirit of St. Philip, let us embrace the joy, love, and unity of the Holy Trinity. May we be inspired by his example to live our faith with a joyful heart, a prayerful spirit, and a loving presence. As we

contemplate the mystery of the Trinity, let us allow this divine love to permeate every aspect of our lives, drawing us closer to God and to one another.

Sacraments

Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

St. Philip Neri Respect Life

But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week. She is now called a "fetus", a Latin word meaning "little one". Ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring, flip and jump – her first dance steps!



Feast Day May 26th

Born July 21, 1515 / Died May 26, 1595

Canonized March 12, 1622

Patron of Rome, US Special Forces, & Humor & Joy

He was the founder of the Congregation of the Oratory, a community of Catholic priests and lay brothers.

Known for being always cheerful, he was referred to as “good little Phil” as a youth. At 18 years old he received a mystical vision, which he eventually spoke of as his Christian conversion. His life was changed and he lost interest in owning property or participating in business.

He felt a radical call to live for and serve Jesus Christ and His Church. He set out for Rome and helped the poor and re-evangelized the city as its inhabitants were no longer really living as Christians. He began talking to

people on street corners and in public squares, anywhere people gathered. He was known for his knack of starting conversations and caught peoples attention with his personality and incredible sense of humor. He helped many to find or rediscover their faith in Christ by spending hours talking and listening to people of all ages. He whole-heartedly desired to reform the Church and worked toward that with a sense of gentleness and

friendship, rather than criticism. He earned the title “Apostle of Rome” and died at 80 years old in 1595.
