Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today we gather to celebrate the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ, also known as Corpus Christi. This Solemnity is a profound reminder of the boundless love Jesus has for each one of us, a love so deep that He desires to be present with us in the most intimate way possible – through the Holy Eucharist.

In today's Gospel, we hear Jesus' words from the Last Supper; "Take, eat; this is my body" and "Drink from it, all of you; for this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many for the forgiveness of sins" (Matthew 26:26-28). These words are not mere symbols; they convey the reality of Jesus's gift of Himself. He gives us His body and blood so that He can remain with us always, nourishing our souls and drawing us closer to Him. The Eucharist is the greatest expression of Christ's love for us. Through it, He fulfills His promise; "I am with you always, to the very end of the age." (Matthew 28:20). In the Eucharist, Jesus is truly present – Body, Blood, Soul, and Divinity. Jesus comes to us in a humble form, under the appearances of bread and wine, so that He can be with us, dwell within us, and transform us. Consider for a moment the humility and love required for Jesus, the Son of God, to make Himself present in such a way. He does not come to us with grandeur or fanfare but in the simplicity of bread and wine.

This humble presence invites us to approach Him with faith, reverence, and love. It reminds us that He is always near, ready to sustain us and strengthen us on our journey of faith. As we reflect on this profound mystery, we are also reminded of the National Eucharistic Revival currently happening throughout the United States. This revival is a call to deepen our understanding and appreciation of the Eucharist. It is an invitation to renew our faith in the real presence of Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament and to rekindle our devotion to this sacrament of love. Our National Eucharistic Revival seeks to reignite our hearts and minds to the truth that in the Eucharist, we encounter the living Christ. It is a movement to help us recognize that the Eucharist is not just a part of our faith but the source and summit of Christian life. This revival encourages us to approach the Eucharist with greater reverence and to make it the center of our lives, shaping how we live, love, and serve others. I encourage you to go to:

www.eucharisticrevival.org for more information. In this time of revival, we are called to a renewed sense of wonder and awe at the gift of the Eucharist. We are encouraged to spend more time with Jesus present at Eucharistic Adoration, to participate more fully in the celebration of Mass, and to allow the grace of the Eucharist to transform our lives. Through these practices, we can deepen our relationship with Jesus and become more like Him, living out His love in our daily lives. As we celebrate Corpus Christi today, let us open our hearts to the immense love that Jesus offers us in the Eucharist. Let us thank Jesus for this incredible gift and renew our commitment to receiving Him with faith and devotion. May our participation in the

Eucharist inspire us to be His presence in the world, bringing His love, peace, and mercy to all we encounter.

Let us pray:

Lord Jesus, we thank You for the gift of Your Most Precious Body and Blood in the Eucharist. Help us to appreciate the depth of your love for us and to approach the Eucharist with reverence and faith. May this time of Eucharistic revival renew our hearts and deepen our relationship with You. Transform us through this sacrament of love so that we may become Your faithful disciples, bringing Your presence to the world. Amen.

Sacraments

Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

St. Philip Neri Respect Life

Your spiritually adopted baby is making progress developing all of her external features and internal organs. Her brain is functioning at 40 days. Her mother can hear her heartbeat now on an ultrasonic stethoscope. Baby teeth buds are present at 6 1/2 weeks. The central nervous system is functioning and 40 muscle sets begin their first exercises. From this moment, your spiritually adopted baby grows and refines her body. But everything she needs to survive after birth is already present by the end of the eighth week. She is now called a "fetus", a Latin word meaning "little one". Ultrasound reveals that this little one can now spring, flip and jump – her first dance steps!

For hundreds of years the Church has dedicated the month of June to the Sacred Heart of Jesus. Pope Leo XIII in 1899 dedicated the entire world to the Sacred Heart. The term "Sacred Heart" incorporates the entire mystery of Christ, Son of God and redeemer of mankind.

Pope John Paul II saw this devotion as an essential component for his "new evangelization". There are many different devotions and novenas, especially notable are the 12 promises of Jesus to St. Margaret Mary Alacoque. In a series of apparitions between 1673 and 1675, Our Lord gave her these promises for those who would make an effort to return His love. This year the feast of the Sacred Heart is June 7th.

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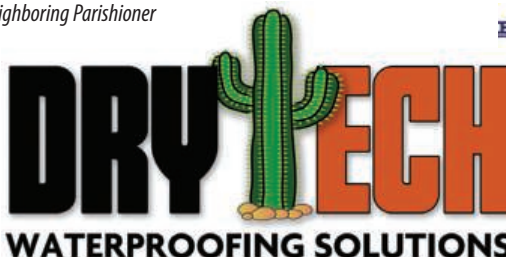
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
