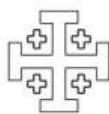

Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today's readings from the Book of Job and the Gospel of Mark present a powerful reflection on the sovereignty of God and the call to trust in His divine power. These passages speak directly to our hearts, especially when we find ourselves amidst life's storms and uncertainties. Let us dive into these scriptures and discover the profound message they hold for us. In our first reading from Job, we encounter God responding to Job out of the whirlwind. Job, having endured immense suffering, is questioning the reasons behind his plight. God's response is a majestic declaration of His authority over creation; "Or who shut the sea with doors when it burst out from the womb...and said, 'thus far shall you come, and no farther, and here shall your proud waves be stayed?'" These verses remind us of the immense power and wisdom of God, who has established the boundaries of the seas and governs all of creation. They invite us to recognize that God's perspective is far beyond our understanding. Just as He set limits for the chaotic waters, He holds control over the complexities and challenges of our lives. In the Gospel of Mark, we see this divine power manifested in Jesus. The disciples are crossing the sea when a fierce storm arises, threatening their safety. Amidst the chaos, Jesus is asleep in the stern, seemingly unaware of the danger. The disciples, terrified, wake Him with a desperate plea; "Teacher, do you not care if we perish?" Jesus' response is both a demonstration of His authority and a lesson in faith. He rebukes the wind and commands the sea, "Peace! Be still!", instantly, the wind ceases, and a great calm ensues. He then turns to His disciples and asks, "Why are you afraid? Have you no faith?" The readings today call us to a deeper trust in God's sovereignty. Just as God's voice from the whirlwind reassured Job of His omnipotence, Jesus' calming of the storm reveals His divine nature and authority over the natural world. In both instances, we are reminded that God is in control, even when circumstances appear dire and our understanding is limited.

Lessons for our lives:

Trust in God's power: We are often like Job or the disciples, caught in the turbulence of life, questioning and fearful. These scriptures invite us to trust in God's power and presence. When we face personal storms – be it illness, loss, or uncertainty – we must remember that God, who created the universe and set the bounds of the sea, is with us. His power is beyond measure, and His love is unceasing.

Faith over fear: Jesus' question to His disciples, "Why are you afraid? Have you no faith?" is a call to replace our fear with faith. Fear often blinds us to God's presence and makes us doubt His care for us. Faith, on the other hand, opens our eyes to see Jesus in our boat, calm and in control, ready to bring peace to our troubled hearts.

God's peace in chaos: The peace that Jesus brings is not merely the absence of trouble but the presence of His calming assurance amidst chaos. This peace is a fruit of our

faith and trust in Him. In our prayer life, let us seek this peace, asking Jesus to still the storms within us and around us. Brothers and sisters, as we reflect on these powerful readings, let us renew our trust in the Lord of creation and calm. Let us remember that the same God who spoke out of the whirlwind and calmed the sea with a word is with us in every moment of our lives. In our moments of fear and uncertainty, may we hear His voice saying, "Peace! Be still!" and find rest in His unfailing love.

Sacraments



Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

Would you like to remember St. Philip in your will?

Confirmation November 4, 2024

Respect Life Corner

Your baby is quite active in the womb now, although his mother won't feel him for another couple of months. If his mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow and move his tongue. He can make a tight fist if you touch his palm. He is breathing amniotic fluid which continues until birth, although he obtains the oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce. Early this month, at just 9 weeks, he began to suck his thumb.
