Dear St. Philip Neri Families & Friends



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today's readings bring us face to face with two pivotal truths of our faith: the origin of death, suffering, and the redeeming power of Jesus Christ. As we reflect on the wisdom from the Old Testament and the healing miracles of Jesus in the Gospel, we find a profound message of hope, redemption, and life. In our first reading from the Book of Wisdom, we hear a powerful affirmation about God's creation: "God did not make death, nor does He rejoice in the destruction of the living" (Wis 1:13) God, in His infinite goodness, created everything for life and incorruptibility. "For God formed man to be imperishable; the image of His own nature He made him" (Wis 2:23). However, the reading also reveals the tragic entry of death into the world; "But by the envy of the devil, death entered the world, and they who belong to His company experience it" (Wis 2:24). This passage helps us understand that sin is the root cause of death and suffering. It was through the envy and deceit of the devil that humanity fell into sin, bringing with it the consequences of suffering and death. The original sin disrupted the perfect harmony of God's creation, introducing a rupture between God and humanity that led to physical and spiritual death. But God, in His boundless love and mercy, did not abandon us nor did He leave us in this state of separation and despair. Throughout salvation history, God was drawing us closer and closer to Himself. He sent His only Son, Jesus Christ, to conquer sin and death and to restore us to eternal life. This is vividly illustrated in today's Gospel from Mark. We see Jesus performing two miracles that highlight His divine authority over life and death. Jairus, a synagogue official, falls at Jesus' feet, pleading for the healing of his dying daughter. On His way to Jairus' house, a woman suffering from hemorrhages for twelve years touches Jesus' cloak in faith, believing that this act will heal her. And indeed, her faith is rewarded as Jesus says, "Daughter, your faith has saved you. Go in peace and be cured of your affliction" (Mk 5:34). Jesus's compassion and power are further demonstrated when He arrives at Jairus' house to find the girl has died. Undeterred, Jesus tells the mourners, "Do not be afraid; just have faith" (Mk 5:36). He then takes the girl by the hand and commands, "Talitha koum", meaning, "Little girl, I say to you arise! (Mk 5:41). Immediately, the girl rises and walks. These miracles are not just demonstrations of Jesus' power but profound signs of His mission to conquer sin and death. By healing the woman and raising the girl from death, Jesus shows that He has come to restore life and to defeat the forces of sin and death that entered the world through the devil's envy. Through His own death and resurrection, Jesus accomplished the ultimate victory over sin and death. By His sacrifice on the cross, He bore the weight of our sins and the consequences of death, and through His resurrection, He opened the way to eternal life for all who believe in Him. As we reflect on these readings, let us recognize the reality of sin and its effects in our lives. We are called to repent and to turn to Jesus, who alone has

the power to heal and restore us. Like the woman with the hemorrhage, we must reach out in faith, trusting in His saving power. Like Jairus, we must believe in His ability to bring life even in the face of death. Let us also be instruments of Christ's healing and life-giving power in the world. Through our words, actions, and prayers, we can bring His light to those who are suffering and in need of hope. In this Eucharist, we encounter the same Jesus who healed the sick and raised the dead. Let us approach Him with faith, confident in His power to conquer sin and death, and to bring us to new life with Him. During this heat spell, if you are looking for a cool, quiet place, please come visit our Church.

Jesus is always here waiting for you!

Sacraments



Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

Would you like to remember St. Philip in your will?

Ask your attorney to include such words as these: "I give, or bequeath to St. Philip Neri Church, 437 Ridge Pike, Lafayette Hill, PA for its general purposes all, or state percentage of the rest, residue, and remainder of my estate, whether real or personal." OR "I give to St. Philip Neri Church \$X to be used for the general purposes of St. Philip Neri Church."

Metropolitan Tribunal

If his mother's womb had a window, you could watch your spiritually adopted baby squint, swallow and move his tongue. He can make a tight fist if you touch his palm. He is breathing amniotic fluid which continues until birth, although he obtains the oxygen his body needs through the umbilical cord. The baby you are praying for weighs one ounce. Early this month, at just 9 weeks, he began to suck his thumb.
