

#### **Baptism**

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

#### **Anointing of the Sick**

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.



Dear St. Philip Neri families & friends, we give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today, we are blessed with readings that speak powerfully of God's providence and His ability to multiply our humble offering

for the good of His people. Let us delve into the first reading from 2<sup>nd</sup> Kings and the Gospel of John, seeing how these passages reflect God's miraculous provision and His deep care for us. In the first reading from 2 Kings 4:42-44, we see the prophet Elisha being approached by a man from Baal-shalishah, bringing twenty barley loaves and fresh grain in his sack. Elisha commands that the food be given to the people. Despite the servant's hesitation, wondering how such a small amount could feed a hundred men, Elisha insists, saying, "For thus says the LORD, 'They shall eat and have some left.'" And indeed, as the Lord has spoken through His prophet, all ate and there was food left over. This Old Testament miracle of multiplication prefigures the greater miracle we find in the Gospel of John 6:1-15. Here,

Jesus sees a large crowd coming toward Him. With compassion, He asks Philip where they can buy bread to feed them. Philip's response is pragmatic, noting that even two hundred denarii worth of bread would not be enough for each person to have a little. Then Andrew, Simon Peter's brother, points out a boy with five barley loaves and two fish, but questions how such a small offering could possibly feed so many. Yet, Jesus takes the loaves and fish, gives thanks, and distributes them to those who were seated, and all ate as much as they wanted. When everyone is satisfied, Jesus instructs His disciples to gather the leftovers so that nothing may be wasted, and they fill twelve baskets with fragments from the five barley loaves.

In both passages, we witness a profound truth: God's ability to multiply what we bring to Him in faith. Whether it is Elisha or Jesus, God shows His power and compassion through acts of miraculous provision. There are several key lessons we can draw from these readings:

1. **God Works Through Our Humble Offerings:** In both stories, the initial offering seems insignificant – twenty barley loaves for a hundred men, and five loaves and two fish for thousands. Yet, when these humble gifts are placed in God's hands, they become more than enough. This reminds us that no matter how small our contributions may seem, God can use them in extraordinary ways. We should never underestimate the value of our gifts, talents, and resources when offered to God in faith.
2. **God Provides Abundantly:** In both miracles, not only is there enough to feed everyone, but there are leftovers. This abundance signifies God's generosity and His desire to provide for His people fully. God's provision is not just sufficient; it is overflowing. This abundance calls us to trust in God's providence, even when we face seemingly insurmountable challenges.

3. **Gratitude and Stewardship:** Jesus' act of giving thanks before distributing the loaves and fish teaches us the importance of gratitude. Recognizing God as the source of all blessings transforms our perception of scarcity into one of abundance. Additionally, Jesus' instruction to gather the leftovers so that nothing is wasted highlights the importance of stewardship. We are called to cherish and wisely manage the gifts God has given us, ensuring that nothing is wasted.

4. **The Eucharistic Significance:** The multiplication of the loaves and fishes is a precursor to the Eucharist. Just as Jesus gave thanks and distributed the bread to feed the multitudes, he offers Himself as the Bread of Life in the Eucharist, feeding us spiritually and sustaining us on our journey. Every time we celebrate the Eucharist, we participate in this divine multiplication, receiving the abundant grace of God through Christ's sacrifice.

As we reflect on these readings, let us ask ourselves; What are the humble offerings in our lives that we can bring to God? How can we cultivate a deeper trust in His providence? Are we truly grateful for His abundant blessings, and how can we be better stewards of the gifts we receive? Let us pray for the grace to recognize and trust in God's miraculous provision in our lives, to offer our gifts with faith and humility, and to always give thanks for His boundless generosity. May our hearts be open to the abundance God wishes to pour into our lives, and may we always share that abundance with others, becoming instruments of His love and provision in the world.


