Sacraments



Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

Dear St. Philip Neri families & friends, we give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us. Today, we are blessed with readings that deeply interconnect the Old and New Testaments, revealing God's continuous providence and His ultimate gift to humanity. As we delve into the Scriptures from Exodus 16:2-4, 12-15 and John 6:24-35, we witness a divine narrative that moves from the physical sustenance of the Israelites to the spiritual nourishment offered by Jesus Christ, the true Bread from Heaven. In the first reading, we find the Israelites in the desert, grumbling against Moses and Aaron due to their hunger. Their physical need for food becomes a test of faith and trust in God's provision. God hears their complaints and responds with the miraculous gift of manna, a fine, flake-like substance that appears on the ground each morning. This bread from heaven sustains them physically throughout their journey in the wilderness. The manna serves as a tangible sign of God's care and a reminder that he is with them, providing for their needs even in the most desolate places. It is also a test, as God instructs them to gather only enough for each day, fostering trust in His daily provision. In the Gospel, we see the crowd seeking Jesus after the miraculous feeding of the five thousand. They are drawn by the physical miracle but fail to grasp its deeper significance. Jesus challenges them, urging them to seek not the perishable bread but the food that endures to eternal life, which He offers. Jesus declares, "I am the bread of life; whoever comes to me will never hunger, and whoever believes in me will never thirst." Here, Jesus reveals Himself as the fulfillment of the manna in the desert. While the manna provided temporary physical sustenance, Jesus, the true Bread from Heaven, offers eternal spiritual nourishment. He invites us to believe in Him, to partake in the divine life He offers, and to find our deepest fulfillment in Him. The connection between the manna in the desert and Jesus as the Bread of Life highlights a profound truth; God's ultimate desire is to draw us into a relationship of trust and communion with Him. The physical hunger of the Israelites and the crowd's pursuit of Jesus after the feeding of the five thousand both point to a deeper spiritual hunger that only God can satisfy. In our lives, we often find ourselves seeking after things that provide temporary satisfaction, much like the Israelites who grumbled for physical bread. However, Jesus calls us to lift our gaze higher and seek the eternal nourishment that He alone can provide. He invites us to a deeper faith, one that trusts in His continual presence and provision, not just for our physical needs but for our spiritual well-being.

As we reflect on these readings, let us ask ourselves:

1) Where do we turn to satisfy our deepest hungers?

Are we seeking temporary solutions in the material world, or are we turning to Jesus, the true Bread of Life?

2) How can we cultivate a deeper trust in God's provision?

Are we willing to rely on His daily grace and guidance, even when we find ourselves in the deserts of life?

3) In what ways can we share this Bread of Life with others?

As followers of Christ, we are called to be His hands and feet, bringing His love and sustenance to those in need. Let us embrace the invitation of Jesus to partake in the true Bread from Heaven. Let us trust in His unfailing provision and allow Him to satisfy our deepest hunger. May our lives be a testament to His love and a source of nourishment for those around us.
