

Dear St. Philip Neri families & friends, we give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us! This Sunday's Gospel reading brings us to a critical moment in the ministry of Jesus, where His teachings begin to challenge even His closest followers. The passage from John 6:60-69 is not just a narrative about the past, but a powerful message for us today. It speaks to the heart of our faith and the difficulties we sometimes encounter in fully embracing the teachings of Christ. In the verse leading up to today's reading, Jesus has been speaking about the Bread of Life, telling His disciples that His flesh is true food and His blood is true drink. This teaching is difficult for many to accept, we hear them say, "This saying is hard; who can accept it?" Jesus' words challenge their understanding and push them to the limits of their faith. How often do we find ourselves in a similar position? The teachings of Christ, as handed down through the Church, sometimes challenge our way of thinking, our lifestyles. Or our understanding of the world. Whether it's the Church's teachings on morality, the sanctity of life, Holy Marriage, filling our Sunday Mass obligation, or the real presence of Christ in the Holy Eucharist, there are moments when we, too, might struggle and say, "This is hard; who can accept it?" When faced with these challenges, some of the disciples choose to turn away. They decided that following Jesus is too difficult, that His words are too demanding. This moment is a reminder to us that true discipleship is not easy. It comes with a cost. Jesus never promised that the path would be simple or that His teachings would always align with the way we naturally think or feel. Rather, they call us to trust in Him, even when His ways are beyond our understanding. In this moment of decision, Jesus turns to the Twelve and asks, "Do you also want to leave?" Peter's response is one of the most beautiful and profound statements of faith in the Gospels: "Master, to whom shall we go? You have the words of eternal life. We have come to believe and are convinced that you are the Holy One of God." Peter's words capture the essence of what it means to be a disciple. Despite the difficulties, despite the moments of doubt or confusion, Peter recognizes that there is no other place to turn. Jesus alone has the words of eternal life. This is a powerful testimony to the trust, surrender and faith that should be at the heart of our relationship with Christ. This passage also points directly to the Blessed Sacrament, the source and summit of our faith. The mystery of the Holy Eucharist is at the center of the teaching that caused many to turn away. The idea that bread and wine could become the Body and Blood of Christ is indeed a profound mystery, one that we accept not because it is easy to understand, but because we trust in the words of Jesus. In Holy Communion, we encounter the living Christ, who offers Himself to us completely, nourishing us with His very life.

As we reflect on today's Gospel, let us examine our own hearts. Are there teachings of Christ or the Church that we find difficult to accept? Are there moments when we are tempted to walk away because the path seems too hard? In those moments, let us remember Peter's confession of faith.

Let us turn to Jesus, the Holy One of God, who alone has the words of eternal life. Let us renew our commitment to follow Jesus, trusting that He will lead us to the fullness of life that He has promised. Amen.

Sacraments



Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.
