



Dear St. Philip Neri families & friends, we give praise and thanks to God for the graces He has given us! This weekend we celebrate two significant feasts: The Exaltation of the Cross and Our Lady of Sorrows.

Both feasts invite us to meditate deeply on the mystery of suffering, love, and the ultimate victory of the cross. These are not easy themes, but they reveal the heart of our faith; the victory of God's love through suffering and sacrifice.

#### **The Exaltation of the Holy Cross**

This feast of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross celebrates the cross not just as a symbol of suffering but as a symbol of victory. When we look at the cross, we see more than the instrument of Christ's death; we see the instrument of our salvation. Through His death on the cross, Jesus transformed what was once a sign of defeat into a sign of hope and triumph over sin and death. But this victory came at a cost – a profound cost of love. Jesus embraced the cross willingly, showing God's love is so deep and radical that He would suffer and die to save us.

The cross is not an easy road, but it is the road of redemption.

#### **Our Lady of Sorrows**

The following day, we remember Our Lady of Sorrows, which draws our hearts toward Mary, the mother of Jesus, who suffered alongside her Son. Tradition reflects on seven sorrows that pierced Mary's heart, beginning with Simeon's prophesy that a sword would pierce her soul.

We can only imagine her suffering as she watched her beloved Son carry His cross and ultimately die on it. Mary's sorrow, however, was not just a passive suffering. It was a deep participation in the mystery of redemption.

She stood at the foot of the cross, sharing in Christ's suffering with a heart full of love and faith. Even in her sorrow, Mary never lost hope; she trusted that God would bring victory from this pain.

#### **Isaiah 50:5-9a: The Suffering Servant's Trust in God**

In our first reading from Isaiah, we hear about the Suffering Servant, a figure who willingly submits to God's will, even when it leads to great pain. This passage mirrors the experience of both Christ on the cross and Mary at its foot. The Servant speaks of offering his back to those who strike him and not hiding from disgrace and spitting, yet he remains steadfast because he knows, "the Lord God is my help." This trust/surrender in God's plan is a powerful reflection of both Jesus' and Mary's attitudes toward suffering. Jesus, the ultimate Suffering Servant, embraced

the cross, and Mary, as the first and perfect disciple, embraced the suffering of her Son with profound trust.

#### **Mark 8:27-35: Peter's misunderstanding and the Call to take up the Cross**

In the Gospel reading, we see another moment of confusion about suffering and the cross. When Jesus asks His disciples, "Who do people say that I am?" Peter responds, "You are the Christ." Peter's proclamation is a moment of deep faith, but when Jesus begins to speak of His impending suffering and death, Peter rebukes Him. Peter, like many of us, struggles with the idea that the Messiah must suffer. Jesus responds with a challenge; "Whoever wishes to come after me must deny himself, take up his cross, and follow me." Here, Jesus is teaching that discipleship involves following Him on a path of suffering and self-sacrifice. Just as He bore the cross, so too must His followers. It's a hard truth, but it's the path to life.

When we tie these readings to the Feasts of the Exaltation of the Holy Cross and Our Lady of Sorrows, we see a common thread; God's plan of salvation is carried out through a loving sacrifice, but this suffering is never without purpose or hope.

Jesus' cross is the ultimate example of how suffering can lead to salvation. When we exalt the cross, we are not celebrating suffering for its own sake, but rather the love and victory that Christ brought through it. The cross is where Jesus conquered sin and death, and it is also the model for our own lives. We, too, are called to take up our crosses and follow Him, trusting that through these crosses, God will bring new life. Mary shows us how to walk this path with grace. She didn't understand everything that was happening, but she stood by her Son, trusting in God's plan. Her heart was pierced with sorrow, but she never lost faith. In her suffering, she teaches us how to unite our sorrows with Christ's, knowing that they, too, can be part of God's redemptive work. The cross we carry might look different for each of us. It might be illness, family struggles, loneliness, financial, mental or spiritual suffering or some hidden sorrow. But whatever our cross is, we are not alone. Jesus carried His cross, and Mary stood beside Him. They now walk with us in our own suffering. We are called to trust and surrender, as they did, that God is always at work, even in the darkest moments. The cross is never the end of the story – it leads to Resurrection and new life.

May God bless you all, please invite someone to Mass.

### Marriage


Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.




