St. Teresa of Jesus / Feast Day Oct 15th



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. Today's readings invite us to reflect on what it means to seek true wisdom and where our priorities lie in life. We see how God's wisdom surpasses all earthly treasures and how the call to follow Jesus demands radical commitment.

First Reading: Wisdom 7:7-11

In the Book of Wisdom, Solomon prays for wisdom, acknowledging that wisdom comes from God. Solomon says that he prayed, and prudence and wisdom were given to him. He then declares that he prefers wisdom over wealth, power, or health, as she is "more precious than scepters and thrones" and greater than gold or silver. Solomon's decision to prioritize wisdom over material possessions shows us the value of seeking what is eternal. Wisdom is not just intellectual knowledge; it is the gift of understanding life from God's perspective. Wisdom helps us recognize what is truly important and how to navigate the complexities of life. Solomon's desire for wisdom over riches shows that when we prioritize God's gifts, everything else falls into place. He says that all good things come along with wisdom, and this resonates with the idea that when we seek God first, we gain everything that we truly need.

Gospel: Mark 10:17-30

In the Gospel, we encounter a rich young man who approaches Jesus with a good question; "What must I do to inherit eternal life?" This is a question that reflects a genuine desire to do what is right, to live a life pleasing to God. Jesus first reminds him of the commandments, which the young man says he has kept since his youth. He has lived a morally good life and followed the laws. Yet, when Jesus looks at him with love and tells him, "You lack one thing; go, sell what you own, and give the money to the poor, and you will have treasure in heaven; come, follow me, the man walks away sad because he has many possessions." This scene illustrates how wealth and attachment to material things can be a barrier to discipleship. The young man's sorrow reveals the grip that his possessions have on his heart. He cannot let go of his earthly riches, even though he desires eternal life. Jesus' response to this is clear, "How hard it is for the rich to enter the Kingdom of God." This is not a condemnation of wealth, but a reminder that material things can take hold of our hearts and distract us from what really matters – following Christ wholeheartedly.

Reflection

Both readings challenge us to examine our values. Solomon recognizes that wisdom, which comes from God, is greater than all riches. The rich young man, however, cannot bring himself to part with his wealth to follow Jesus. At times we can be like the young man – desiring to follow Christ but held back by our attachments. It may not be wealth, but other things that we hold dear, such as our comfort, status, or security. Jesus invites us to trust in God and seek His wisdom above all else. If we rely on His grace and surrender our attachments, God will lead us to true freedom and eternal life.

Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.
