We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. In today's readings, we are invited to reflect on the mystery of suffering and service – two themes central to the Christian Faith. In the first reading from Isaiah 53:10-11, we hear about the "Suffering Servant", a prophecy that points to Jesus. Isaiah tells us that "... it was the Lord's will to crush him with pain." This might sound harsh, but it reveals something crucial about God's plan. The suffering of the servant isn't without purpose. Through this suffering, he takes on the sins of many and, by doing so, brings healing and life to others. It's a foreshadowing of Christ's passion, where Jesus, the innocent one, suffers to save us from sin and death. Isaiah reminds us that suffering can have meaning when it's united to God's will and offered for others. Jesus teaches us this through His life, death, and resurrection. Even in moments of great pain and hardship, God is working out His plan for salvation, not just for the individual but for the entire world. In today's Gospel from Mark 10:35-45, Jesus asks them, "Can you drink the cup I drink or be baptized with the baptism I am baptized with?" He's talking about His suffering and death, the cup of sacrifice He will endure on the cross. The brothers say they can, but Jesus points out that true greatness doesn't come from sitting in places of honor – it comes from serving others. He says, "whoever wants to be great among you must be your servant, and whoever wants to be first must be the slave of all." This flips the world's idea of greatness upside down. In our world, greatness is often measured by how much power or status someone has, but Jesus teaches that true greatness is found in serving others, especially those in need. At the heart of this teaching is Jesus Himself. He says, "For the Son of Man did not come to be served, but to serve, and to give His life as a ransom for many." Jesus is the ultimate servant leader. He didn't cling to His divine privileges but gave them up, becoming one of us, even dying on the cross for our sake. His whole mission was to save humanity. This is a powerful challenge for us. We all want to follow Jesus, but are we willing to follow Him all the way to the cross? Are we willing to serve others, even when it costs us something? Sometimes, we may want to avoid suffering, or we may want to pursue positions of honor like James and John. But Jesus shows us that the path to real glory, to true greatness, is the path of humility, sacrifice, and love. As we approach the altar today, let us ask for the grace to embrace the path of service and sacrifice, just as Jesus did. Let us pray for the strength to drink the cup of sacrifice when it is asked of us, and the wisdom to see that in serving others, we are following the greatest example of all – Jesus Christ, our Lord.

Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

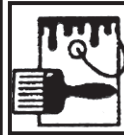
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
