We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. As we come to the end of October, a month dedicated both to Respect Life and to the Rosary, today's Gospel from Mark 10:46-52 presents us with a powerful message of faith, healing, and the value of every human life. We hear the story of Bartimaeus, a blind man sitting by the roadside, begging. He cries out to Jesus, "Son of David, have pity on me!" Despite the crowd trying to silence him, Bartimaeus persists. His cry is not just for physical sight but for a deeper encounter with Jesus. Jesus hears him and responds, "What do you want me to do for you?" Bartimaeus' answer is simple; "Master, I want to see." Jesus heals him, not because of his eloquence, but because of his faith. The Gospel offers us two important reflections as we conclude this special month:

1. Respect for Life

Bartimaeus's story reminds us that each life, no matter its condition, is precious in God's eyes. Jesus didn't walk by or dismiss Bartimaeus because of his blindness or his lowly status as a beggar. He stopped, listened, and responded to his plea with love and mercy. In the same way, we are called to recognize the dignity of every human being – whether they are unborn, disabled, elderly, or vulnerable. Every life is valuable. Respect Life Month has invited us to reflect on how we can protect and uphold the sanctity of life from conception to natural death. As followers of Christ, we must reject a culture that discards life when it seems inconvenient or burdensome and instead stand up for the voiceless, just as Bartimaeus boldly called out to Jesus.

2. Faith and the Rosary

In this Month of the Rosary, we are reminded of our Blessed Mother, Mary, and her role in leading us closer to her Son. Like Bartimaeus, Mary's life was a journey of faith. When the angel appeared to her, she said "yes" to God's plan, despite the uncertainties ahead. Through her example, we learn how to respond in trust to God's call. The Rosary is a powerful tool to help us grow in this faith. As we meditate on the mysteries of Christ's life, we invite Mary to intercede for us, guiding us to open our hearts to the healing, mercy, and love of Jesus. In today's Gospel, when Bartimaeus regained his sight, he immediately followed Jesus on the road. He didn't return to his old way of life but became a disciple. This is the invitation for all of us today.

Jesus asks each one of us, "What do you want me to do for you?" Let our answer be like Bartimaeus'; "Lord, I want to see." I want to see others with the love and compassion you have for them. I want to see life as precious and sacred. I want to see the path you are calling me to walk. As we continue our journey of faith, may we pray the rosary with fervor, defend life with courage, and trust that Christ's love will heal and guide us, just as it did for Bartimaeus.

May God bless you all, please invite someone to Mass today.

Sacraments



Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.
