November is the Month of All Souls



The Catechism defines purgatory as a "purification, so
as to achieve the holiness necessary to enter the joy of
heaven," which is experienced by those "who die in
God's grace and friendship, but still imperfectly
purified."

*"It is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray
for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins." 2
Maccabees 12:46*



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! As we near the end of the Liturgical Year, our readings point to the end of times, with messages of hope and warning. The prophet Daniel envisions a time of great distress, with St. Michael, the archangel, standing guard over God's people.

In the Gospel, Jesus speaks of cosmic signs and upheavals that will precede His return. Though both readings highlight troubling events, they also bring a clear message: God remains faithful, and His protection is assured for those who trust in Him. In Daniel's vision, St. Michael, the great prince, appears as a guardian of God's people. Historically, this role reflects times of great difficulty for Israel. They were facing persecution, exile, and threats to their faith and identity. Daniel's prophecy reminds us that God does not abandon His people in times of crisis. St. Michael, as the protector, embodies God's care and strength, providing a promise of deliverance to those who remain faithful. St. Michael's role is not limited to history. He continues to be a guardian for the Church today, battling evil and interceding for us. This protection isn't just about being spared from hardship; it's a call to live in faith, especially during dark or confusing times. God's people are not promised freedom from suffering, but they are promised ultimate victory over evil and death through God's love and protection. The Gospel of Mark reminds us that even though we do not know the day or the hour, we are called to watchfulness and trust. Jesus speaks of dramatic signs in the heavens, and these signs are not meant to frighten us but to inspire a deep readiness. He invites us to be aware, to live each day as if it were our last, to stay grounded in faith and trust. The apocalyptic language may seem intimidating, but we must remember that, as followers of Christ, we live with the assurance of God's eternal love. Jesus does not tell us these things to fill us with fear but to anchor us in hope. We are reminded that even as things fall apart around us, God's Word will not pass away. His promises endure, His love is steadfast, and His mercy is constant. In both Daniel and Mark, we are shown that God's presence is real and active, even in the midst of chaos and we have a choice in how we respond. Are we, like the wise in Daniel's vision, leading others toward righteousness? Are we living our faith with courage and helping others to see God's goodness, even in hard times? St. Michael stands as a reminder of God's power and protection, but we, too, are called to be protectors-of faith, hope, and of love. May we pray for St. Michael's intercession, asking him to strengthen us and give us courage. And may we remain watchful, living each day with the assurance that we are not alone. God's love surrounds us, and His protection is sure.

May God bless you all, please invite someone to Mass today.

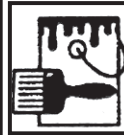
