November is the Month of All Souls



"It is therefore a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from sins." 2 Maccabees 12:46



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! Today, we celebrate the Solemnity of Our Lord Jesus Christ, King of the Universe, a day when we honor Christ's kingship and reflect on the kind of kingdom He brings – a kingdom vastly different from earthly empires. This feast reminds us that Christ's rule is not based on power or wealth but on love, mercy, and self-giving sacrifice. As we approach Thanksgiving, a holiday that invites us to gather and express our gratitude, these two themes converge beautifully. The readings today remind us of what it means to have Christ as our King. In the Gospel, Jesus tells Pilate, "My kingdom does not belong to this world." His rule does not come from military might or privileges of the powerful. Instead, His kingdom is a kingdom of service, humility, and love. Christ as King bends down to serve, heals the sick, reaches out to the marginalized, and calls each of us to do the same. His crown is not made of gold but of thorns; His throne is not of splendor but the wood of the cross. On Thanksgiving, many of us are blessed to gather with family and friends, sharing food and fellowship. Yet, this feast invites us to look beyond our own blessings and remember those who are less fortunate.

Thanksgiving can become an opportunity to embrace Christ's way of serving others and to see gratitude as more than just words – it's an invitation to act. Christ our King teaches us that gratitude for God's gifts should overflow into how we treat one another, especially those in need.

How do we bring Christ's kingdom to life this week? Perhaps it's by reaching out to a lonely neighbor, volunteering to help those without food, or simply pausing to thank God more deeply.

As we gather around our tables, let's remember that we're part of Christ's family, called to love and serve as He did. This Thanksgiving, may we honor Christ the King by living with grateful hearts that serve, for this is what it truly means to be citizens of His kingdom. In our gratitude and service, we give thanks to our King, who rules not from afar, but in the depths of our hearts, calling us to love that transforms. Amen

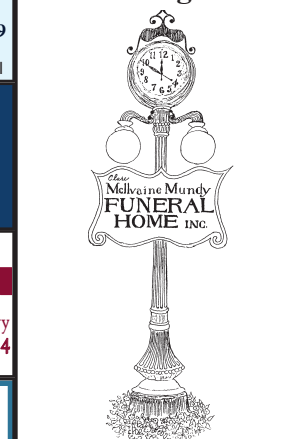
