

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! Advent marks the beginning of a new liturgical year and is a season of hope and preparation. Today's readings invite us to reflect on the promises of God and the posture of readiness that should characterize our lives as we await the coming of Christ. In Jeremiah, we hear a message of hope delivered to a people in the midst of hardship. God promises to send a righteous Branch from the line of David, a savior who will bring justice and peace. This promise, fulfilled in Jesus Christ, reminds us that God is faithful. Even in the darkest moments of our lives, God's promises endure. Advent is a time to rekindle our trust in that faithfulness and to remember that God always works for our good, even when the path seems unclear. The Gospel from Luke speaks of signs in the heavens, the distress of nations, and the shaking of the world. These apocalyptic images can feel unsettling, but Jesus' message is one of encouragement; "Stand erect and raise your heads because your redemption is at hand." For Christians, these signs are not reasons to fear but reminders to remain vigilant and hopeful. The Lord's coming will be a moment of triumph for those who trust Him. Jesus also warns us against the dangers of distraction; "Beware that your hearts do not become drowsy." How easy it is, especially during the holiday season, to become consumed by busyness, materialism, or anxiety. Advent calls us to slow down, reflect, and refocus on what truly matters: our relationship with God and how we live out His love in the world. To "be vigilant" at all times" means to live each day with purpose and awareness of God's presence. We prepare for Christ's coming not only by looking to the future but by seeking Him in the here and now – in prayer, in the sacraments, and in the people around us. This Advent, let us embrace the hope of Jeremiah's prophecy and the watchfulness Jesus urges. May we trust in God's promises, stay alert to His presence, and stand ready to welcome Him into our hearts. As we light the first Advent candle, let it remind us that Christ, our light, is near.

"The days are coming says the Lord, when I will fulfill the promise I made."

Let us prepare with joy and hope.

May God bless you all, please invite someone to Mass today.


