We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. Today, we reflect the Wedding Feast at Cana. This passage beautifully illustrates how Jesus and our Blessed Mother, Mary, work behind the scenes in our lives, even when we are unaware of their presence and aid. At the wedding feast, the bride and groom faced an embarrassing situation; they had run out of wine.

This could have been a moment of great shame and disappointment for them. Yet, Mary noticed their need and brought it to Jesus' attention, saying, "They have no wine." Even though it was not yet Jesus' time to reveal Himself openly, Jesus responded to His mother's intercession and performed His first miracle, turning water into wine. The guests and even the bride and groom were likely unaware of the divine intervention that had just occurred. They simply enjoyed the abundant and excellent wine provided. This miracle at Cana reminds us that Jesus and Mary are always present in our lives, working behind the scenes to provide for our needs, even when we do not recognize their involvement. Like the bride and groom, we often face moments of need, struggle, or embarrassment. In those times, we may not see how Jesus and Mary are intervening, but they are there, quietly guiding, protecting, and providing for us. We are called to trust in this unseen assistance. Jesus is our Good Shepherd, as He Himself said, "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep" (John 10:11). A shepherd's role is to guide, protect, and care for the sheep, often in ways the sheep do not fully understand or see. Similarly, Jesus is always watching over us, guiding us through the trials and challenges of life. Mary, too, is our loving Mother, always interceding on our behalf. Her role at Cana exemplifies her maternal care and her powerful intercession. She notices our needs and brings them to Jesus, even before we are aware of them ourselves. Her trust in Jesus' power and love is a model for us. She tells the servants, "Do whatever He tells you." This simple yet profound instruction invites us to place our trust in Jesus, to listen to His word, and to follow His guidance. In our daily lives, we may not always see the immediate results of our prayers or understand how Jesus and Mary are working in our favor. However, we are called to keep our faith and trust in them. Like the wine at Cana, their help may come in unexpected and miraculous ways, transforming our ordinary experiences into moments of grace and abundance. Let us take comfort in the knowledge that Jesus and Mary are always with us, even when we cannot see their presence. Let us trust in their loving care and guidance, knowing that they are working behind the scenes for our good. And let us follow Mary's example by bringing our needs to Jesus with faith and trust, confident that He will provide in His perfect way and timing.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.
