

Archbishop Pérez published a Pastoral Letter on Sunday, January 5th. This letter outlines his hopes for the Church of Philadelphia over the coming years. We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. Today, we celebrate the Feast of the Presentation of the Lord, a moment filled with profound symbolism and significance. Forty days after His birth, Mary and Joseph brought Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem, fulfilling the Law of Moses that every firstborn male be consecrated to the Lord. This act of obedience underscores that Jesus did not come to abolish the law but to fulfill it, illuminating the deep connection between God's covenant with Israel and the salvation He extends to the entire world.

In today's Gospel, we meet two remarkable figures: Simeon and Anna. These elderly, faithful servants of God dedicated their lives to prayer and the anticipation of the Messiah. Simeon's prophetic words, known as the *Nunc Dimittis*, resonate across the ages: "Now, Lord, let your servant go in peace. My eyes have seen your salvation, which you have prepared in the sight of all nations – a light for revelation to the Gentiles, and the glory of your people Israel."

This "light" Simeon speaks of is Jesus Christ, the Light of the World. His coming dispels the darkness of sin and death, bringing hope to all who walk in faith.

Today is also known as Candlemas Day, a tradition where the Church blesses the candles to be used in liturgies throughout the year. Christ's declaration, "I am the Light of the World", reminds us of the significance of lighted candles on the altar at every Mass and the sanctuary candle that signifies His presence in the tabernacle. Let the Light of Christ encourage and strengthen you. May His Light, kindled within us, shine through our actions and words for others to see.

This feast invites us to reflect on our calling to carry the Light of Christ into the world. Like Mary and Joseph, who humbly presented Jesus in the Temple, we are called to offer our lives to God as living sacrifices of love and service. From Simeon and Anna, we learn the virtues of patience and perseverance in faith. They waited their entire lives to see the fulfillment of God's promise, trusting in His perfect timing. In our own lives, we may find ourselves in seasons of waiting – for healing, clarity, or answered prayers. This feast reassures us that God's promises are always fulfilled, though perhaps not in the ways or times we expect.

As we celebrate today, let us ask ourselves: How are we bringing the Light of Christ into our homes, workplaces, and communities? Are we presenting our lives to God with the humility and trust of Mary and Joseph? Are we, like Simeon and Anna, faithfully seeking God's presence in our daily lives? May this feast renew our commitment to live as bearers of Christ's light, so that through our words and actions, others may come to know the salvation and peace that only He can bring.

May God bless you all.

Blessing of Candles

Originally celebrated in the Eastern Churches as "The Meeting" or "encountering", it is mankind encountering their Lord. By the sixth century it began to be celebrated in the West, where the focus became the Purification of Mary and was accompanied by solemn blessings and processions with candles; hence, it is popularly called "Candlemas". Today's Gospel tells us Jesus is "a light for revelation to the Gentiles" thus the blessing of candles to be used in the Church throughout the year. Blessed candles, representing Christ as the Light of the World, are available to take home at the doors of the Church.

Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.
