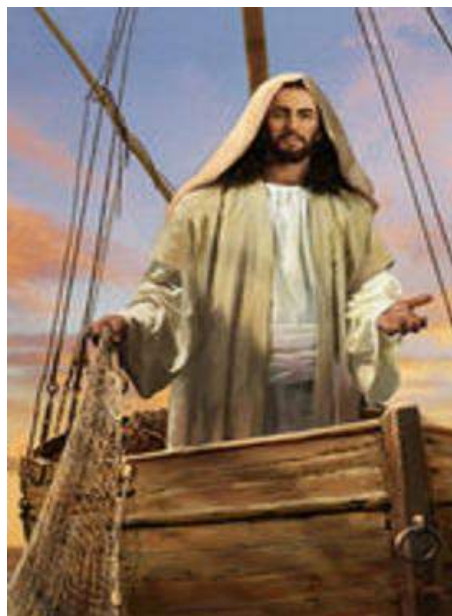

“Your right hand saves me. The Lord will complete what he has done for me; your kindness, O Lord, endures forever; forsake not the work of your hands.”



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. In today's readings, we are challenged to see our world differently – to embrace God's wisdom over human understanding. The prophet Jeremiah reminds us of the contrast between trusting in human strength and trusting in the Lord. He says that those who put their trust in man are like dry shrubs in the desert, while those who trust in God are like trees planted by the water, always bearing fruit. This imagery speaks to the very foundation of our faith; where do we place our trust? Do we rely on our own wisdom, our own success, or the approval of the world? Or do we place our lives fully in God's hands, even when His ways seem difficult or uncertain?

Jesus takes this lesson even further in the Gospel of Luke. He turns the Jewish values at that time upside down. The poor, the hungry, those who weep, and those who were seen as sinners – these are the ones He calls blessed. Meanwhile, those who are rich, full, laughing, and praised by others – these are the ones He warns of woes. This message is radical because it challenges our normal way of thinking. Our society sees wealth, success, and comfort as signs of blessing. But Jesus teaches that true blessing comes from not material things but from our closeness to God.

God's blessing often comes in unexpected ways. He is near to those who are struggling, to those whom the society may overlook. Our Good Shepherd sees the heart, not outward appearances. Jesus is inviting us to adopt God's perspective – to look at our own lives and the lives of others not through worldly measures of success but through the lens of God's love and justice.

This can be challenging to us. It's not easy to trust in God when our society tells us otherwise. It's not easy to see suffering as an opportunity for blessing. But if we root ourselves in God, as Jeremiah describes, we will have deep, unshakable faith even in times of drought and difficulty. So today, let us ask ourselves; Where do I place my trust? Am I seeking the world's approval, or am I seeking God's wisdom? Do I see others the way God sees them, or do I judge by human standards? May we grow in faith, learning to trust in God's ways, even when they seem upside down to the world.

Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

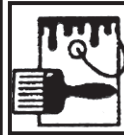
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
