Join the Knights of Columbus on Wednesday, March 12th in the Church for our rosary. Bring your special intentions to our Mother Mary and ask her intercession.

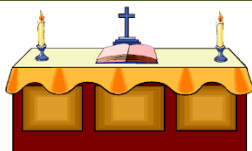
Pre Jordan / Baptismal Instruction

"The Lord is kind and merciful."



We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us. In today's readings, we are challenged by one of the most difficult teachings of Jesus' *Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you.*" (Luke 6:27-28) These words are radical. They go against our natural inclination for justice or even revenge. Yet, Jesus does not simply ask us to tolerate our enemies – He commands us to love them. This is impossible on our own. We can only live this teaching by the grace of God, and the model for this kind of love is God Himself, as Psalm 103:8-10 reminds us: "*The Lord is kind and merciful, slow to anger, and abounding in love. He does not deal with us according to our sins, nor repay us according to our iniquities.*" How often do we withhold this mercy from others? How often do we keep grudges in our hearts, refusing to forgive? And yet, do the people we hold grudges against even think of us? Often, they have moved on while we remain imprisoned by our anger. When we refuse to forgive, we allow them to take up space in our hearts that belongs to God.

Who do we need to forgive?

Each of us carries wounds – some small, some deep. Some of us have been betrayed, insulted, or neglected.

Sometimes, we hold onto these hurts like treasures, replaying them in our minds, keeping the pain alive.

But let us ask ourselves:

- Do the people we hold grudges against even think of us?
- Are we allowing them to occupy space in our hearts that belongs to God?

Unforgiveness does not imprison the other person – it imprisons us. It blocks the grace of God from flowing freely in our lives. Jesus commands us to forgive, not as an option, but as a necessity for our own freedom and salvation. Let us ask ourselves today: Whom do I need to forgive? From whom do I need to seek forgiveness? Let us not delay in being reconciled with God and with one another. The grace to forgive comes not from our own strength but from Christ, who loved us even while we were still sinners. May we turn to Him and allow His mercy to flow through us. Jesus' teaching is not just about being kind – it's about our salvation. "*Forgive, and you will be forgiven.*" (Luke 6:37) This is why the Sacrament of Reconciliation is so important. St. Philip Neri advised that no Christian should go more than 14 days without confession. St. Padre Pio compared confession to a bath for the soul, reminding us that even an empty room gathers dust over time. Forgiveness is not just about what we give – it is also about what we receive. When was the last time I went to confession? St. Philip Neri wisely taught, "**A Christian should not go more than 14 days without confession.**" St. Padre Pio likened confession to the "**souls' bath**", reminding us that even a clean room gathers dust over time. How often do we let the dust of sin accumulate in our souls, dulling our hearts to the love of God? Loving our enemies, forgiving those who hurt us, and seeking reconciliation are impossible tasks without God's help. But He does not leave us alone. Through the sacraments, especially confession and the Eucharist, He strengthens us to live as He commands. May the mercy of God fill us and transform us so that we may reflect His love to the world.

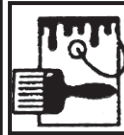
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
