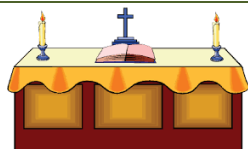

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! Today's Gospel from Luke 6:39-45 reminds us of the importance of self-awareness, humility, and the fruits of our hearts. Jesus begins with a striking image: *"Can a blind person guide a blind person? Will not both fall into a pit?"* (Luke 6:39). He warns us not to be so quick to judge others while failing to see our own faults. Before we try to correct our neighbor, we must first examine our own hearts. How often do we notice the "speck" in someone else's eye while ignoring the "beam" in our own eye? It's easy to criticize others, but Jesus calls us to first look inward. Lent is just around the corner, and this is the perfect time to ask ourselves: *Where do we need to grow? What sins cloud my vision?* Only when we acknowledge our own weaknesses can we truly help others with love and humility. Jesus also tells us, *"A good tree does not bear rotten fruit, nor does a rotten tree bear good fruit."* Our words and actions reveal the condition of our hearts. If our hearts are filled with resentment, pride, or selfishness, then our words and actions will reflect that. But if we root ourselves in Christ – through prayer, the sacraments, and actions of love – then we will bear good fruit: kindness, patience, forgiveness, and truth. So today, let's ask the Lord to purify our hearts. May He open our eyes to our own faults, guide us in humility, and help us bear fruit that glorifies Him. Please keep Pope Francis in your prayers – May God hold Pope Francis in His arms with His Fatherly Love and Comfort. Mary, Our Mother, pray for him.

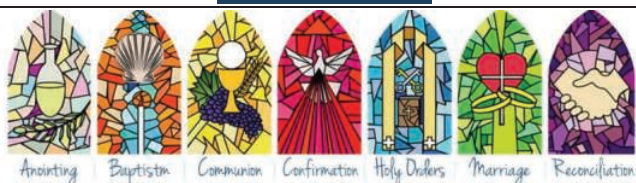

Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2nd & 4th Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass.

Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

meaning springtime or lengthening of the day. It is the
season the Church gives us to rearrange our priorities,
to focus on what matters most. An invitation to embark
on a journey taking our spiritual life more seriously,
abandoning bad habits, and internalizing the Easter
message; “Be not afraid...for He is risen.” A reflective,
somber time where the word “Alleluia” will not be
heard nor will the Gloria be said at Mass and altars are
only sparsely decorated. Purple is the color of the season
to symbolize our need for repentance, and Jesus as King
taken from the Gospels where Pontius Pilate puts a
purple robe on Jesus after the scourging. Don't let this

life, maybe attend a weekday Mass (8:30AM)
