### **Easter Sunday, April 20<sup>th</sup>**

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings He has given us! Today we enter Holy Week – the most sacred time in our faith. We begin with palm branches raised high, shouting “*Hosanna!*”, and within minutes, we are immersed in the Passion of Christ, crying “*Crucify Him!*” This dramatic shift is not just storytelling – it reflects the depth of our human hearts, and more importantly, the depths of God’s great love for us.

Jesus enters Jerusalem not as a warrior, but as a servant. He rides on a donkey, not a war horse, and He walks forward, knowing full well what lies ahead: betrayal, denial, abandonment, the agony of the Cross. But still, He chooses love. He chooses you.

The Passion is not just a sad story; it is the story of God’s love in action. Every wound, every insult, every step Jesus takes is His way of saying, “*I will carry your pain. I will enter your suffering. I will not let you be alone in your brokenness.*”

When Jesus opens His arms on the Cross, He is not just dying. He is offering. He offers us a place to come close, to be healed. Those arms, stretched wide in pain, become the very arms that embrace us and draw us back into the heart of the Father.

Think of your own life – your struggles, your regrets, your wounds. Jesus is not afraid of them. He doesn’t ask you to hide them. He wants you to bring them to the Cross, where they can be transformed – not by force, but by love.

This Holy Week, Jesus invites us to stay close. Not just to remember what happened 2,000 years ago, but to walk with Him *now*. To stay with Him in the quiet of the Garden, in the pain of the Cross, and in the mystery of His sacrifice. Because He is not just walking to Calvary – He is walking *toward us*.

Let us not be afraid of the Cross. Let us not shy away from our wounds or our need for healing. Jesus’ Passion is proof that there is no place too broken, no heart too far gone, no life too lost for His love to reach. His open arms on the Cross are for *you*.

So today, as we hold our palms and prepare to enter the mystery of Holy Week, let us remember; this is not a ritual. It’s a love story. A story of a God who came close, who suffered with us, and who still says today:

***“Come to Me. Stay with Me. Let Me love you back to life.”***

***Hosanna to the Son of David!***

***Blessed is He who comes to save us through love that never ends.***

## Sacraments



### Baptism

Baptisms are scheduled on the 2<sup>nd</sup> & 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of every month immediately following the 11AM Mass. Godparents need Letters of Eligibility, for first time parents the Pre-Jordan Class is required. Call the Church Office at 610-834-1975 to make arrangements.

### Marriage

Arrangements must be made with a priest at least 6 months prior to wedding date. Pre-Cana classes are required, contact Church office at 610-834-1975.

### Anointing of the Sick

Primarily intended as prayers and anointing for healing from serious illness or as a spiritual preparation before surgery. Last Rites or Extreme Unction are for those in danger of imminent death. Call rectory or Church Office.

### Pre Jordan / Baptismal Instruction

If you are having your first child baptized, the archdiocese requires the parents to attend a Pre-Jordan Class. Deacon Mike Cipressi hosts these virtual classes on a monthly basis.

### Why Palm?

In the ancient Near East, the palm branch was a symbol of victory, triumph, peace and eternal life. The tree is usually 40-50 feet tall but can reach 80 feet and provides much needed shade in a very hot climate. It does not bear fruit for 6 to 8 years after planting, but it's worth the wait as the fruits are highly nutritious. Its branches were used as roofing, for baskets, sandal making and medicinal purposes. It is mentioned throughout Scripture; Genesis, Isaiah, Jeremiah, Ezekiel, Psalms, Kings and in the New Testament. Palm branches were often depicted on coins and decorative carvings, symbolizing goodness and well-being and used in the celebration of festive occasions. Kings and conquerors were welcomed home with palm branches being strewn before them and waived by admiring people along the route. Christ received such a welcome in Jerusalem on that first "Holy Week" over two thousand years ago. This is Palm Sunday, the beginning of our solemn remembrance of our Lord's passion, death and resurrection. Please join us for the Sacred Liturgies, as we commemorate these mysteries as a parish family.
