Dear St. Philip Neri Family and Friends,

We give praise and thanks to God for the graces and blessings.

Today's Gospel gives us one of the most beautiful and relatable resurrection stories: the journey to Emmaus.

Two disciples are walking away from Jerusalem—away from the place of hope, away from the place where everything had seemed to fall apart. They are discouraged, confused, and heartbroken. “We were hoping...” they say. Those words carry such weight. “We were hoping...” We've all said that at some point. We were hoping for healing. We were hoping for answers. We were hoping things would turn out differently.

And so, like those disciples, we sometimes walk away—away from hope, away from faith, maybe even away from God. But here is the heart of the Gospel: even when they are walking away, Jesus is already walking with them. They don't recognize Him. Their eyes are prevented from seeing. And isn't that often true for us? The Lord is present—in our lives, in our struggles, in our conversations—but we don't always see Him. We expect Him in dramatic ways, yet He comes quietly, gently, often disguised in the ordinary. Jesus walks with them. He listens. He lets them speak their disappointment.

Then—Jesus begins to interpret their story through the lens of Scripture. He helps them understand that the suffering, the Cross, was not the end—but part of God's saving plan.

And something begins to change. Later they say, “Were not our hearts burning within us while He spoke to us on the way?” That's a key moment. Before they recognize Jesus with their eyes, they experience Him in their hearts. Faith often begins there—not with clarity, but with a stirring.

A warmth. A sense that God is speaking, even if we don't fully understand.

And then comes the turning point: they invite Him in. “Stay with us,” they say. That simple invitation changes everything. At table, Jesus takes bread, blesses it, breaks it, and gives it to them—and in that moment, their eyes are opened. They recognize Him in the breaking of the bread. This is no coincidence. This is Eucharistic language. The same actions we hear at every Mass. The same way we encounter the risen Christ today—not just in memory, but in reality.

And notice: as soon as they recognize Him, He vanishes from their sight. Why? Because now they know where to find Him. Not just on the road—but in the Eucharist. In the community. In the Word. In the breaking of the bread. And what do they do next? Even though it is night, even though they are tired, they immediately return to Jerusalem. They go back—not with fear, but with joy. Not with confusion, but with mission. That is what an encounter with the risen Christ does. It moves us. It sends us. It transforms us. So today, this Gospel asks us a few simple but profound questions:

Where am I on the journey? Am I walking away from something—hope, faith, trust?

Do I recognize Jesus walking with me, even in confusion? And perhaps most importantly:

Have I invited Him to stay?

If we make that prayer our own, He will come. He will speak to our hearts. He will reveal Himself—especially here, at this altar, in the Eucharist.

And then, like those disciples, we will not be able to keep it to ourselves. Our hearts will burn. Our eyes will be opened. And our lives will point others back to Him.

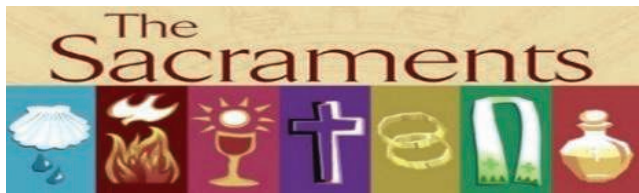
