Dear St. Philip Neri Family and Friends,

We give praise and thanks to God for His graces and blessings. Today, on this beautiful feast of Corpus Christi, we celebrate the great gift of the Holy Eucharist, the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ. The Eucharist is one of the greatest ways that Jesus fulfills His promise: ***"I am with you always, until the end of the age."*** Jesus does not leave us alone. He remains with us, truly present in the Blessed Sacrament. In the Gospel, Jesus tells us, ***"I am the living bread that came down from heaven."*** Jesus gives us His glorified Body and Blood as spiritual food for our journey through life.

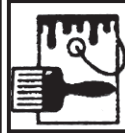
