Dear St. Philip Neri Family and Friends,

We give praise and thanks to God for His graces and blessings. One of the greatest gifts God gives to us is His Word. Throughout Sacred Scripture, we see a God who continually speaks to His people. He speaks words of love, mercy, guidance, encouragement, and hope. Yet one of the challenges of the spiritual life is not whether God is speaking, but whether we are listening. In today's first reading from the prophet Isaiah, God reminds us that His Word is powerful and effective. Just as rain and snow fall from the heavens and nourish the earth, making it fertile and fruitful, so too God's Word accomplishes His purpose. It never returns to Him empty. God's Word always bears fruit.

The question for us is: What kind of soil are we?

In the Gospel, Jesus tells us the familiar parable of the Sower. What is striking is how generously the Sower scatters the seed. He throws it everywhere—on the path, on rocky ground, among thorns, and on rich soil. The Sower does not hold back. He spreads the seed abundantly. Some people might look at the Sower and think that he is not being very wise. Why would he throw seed onto the path, onto rocky ground, or among thorns? He already knows that much of that seed will not produce a harvest. Yet he continues to sow generously and without hesitation. This is precisely how God treats us. God does not wait until we are perfect before He speaks to us. He does not withhold His grace until we have everything figured out. He does not judge us as unworthy or refuse to plant His Word within us because of our weaknesses and failures. Instead, He continually pours out His love, mercy, and grace upon all people. He keeps sowing the seed of His Word into our hearts, hoping that one day the hard ground will soften, the rocks will be removed, the thorns will be cleared away, and His Word will take root and bear abundant fruit. This is a beautiful image of God. God is constantly spreading the seeds of His Word and His grace throughout our lives. He has not stopped speaking to us. He has not abandoned us. He continues to be present, blessing us, guiding us, and inviting us closer to Himself. Sometimes God speaks through Sacred Scripture. Sometimes through prayer. Sometimes through the Mass and the Sacraments. Sometimes through family members, friends, teachers, or even through unexpected events in our lives. God's voice is always present for those willing to listen. Yet we live in a world filled with noise and distractions. There are so many voices competing for our attention. The world tells us that God is distant, that He does not care, that He is not listening, and that He does not speak to us. But as Christians, we know that this is not true. We believe in a God who knows us by name. We believe in a God who listens to every prayer, sees every tear, understands every struggle, and walks beside us every day. We believe in a God who loves us more than we can imagine.

But to hear that voice, sometimes we need to become quiet.

The constant noise of our lives can make it difficult to hear what God is saying. We fill our days with schedules, phones, televisions, social media, and endless distractions. Yet God often speaks in the silence of our hearts. When we make time for prayer, when we spend a few moments in quiet before the Blessed Sacrament, when we open the Scriptures and reflect on them, we create fertile ground where God's Word can take root. Trusting God's Word is not always easy. Sometimes His teachings challenge us. Sometimes His plans are different from our plans. Sometimes He asks us to forgive when we would rather hold a grudge, to love when it is difficult, or to trust when we cannot see the path ahead. Yet God's Word is always for our benefit. It is always meant to lead us closer to Him and help us grow in holiness. If we allow God's Word to take root in our hearts, it will change us. It will strengthen our faith, deepen our hope, and increase our love. It will help us become the people God created us to be.

And when that seed grows within us, others will notice. They will see the fruits of patience, kindness, compassion, forgiveness, generosity, and faith. They will see Christ living within us.

I pray for you every day, especially at Mass. Please pray for me.

Please invite someone to Mass today.

Once again this summer we will be working on several important projects. Remodeling & updating 2 girl's rest rooms. The 5th grade classrooms (trailers contained within brick walls, installed in the 90's) are receiving new ceiling, lighting, ventilation. electrical outlets, flooring, windows, carpeting, and fresh paint. New carpeting will be installed throughout our school hallways. ZeroEyes, a proactive visual gun detection and situational awareness platform, working alongside digital security cameras to rapidly detect dangerous suspicious situations, providing valuable time for individuals to move to safety. DefenSafe/DefenseLite security film will be installed on glass entrances on 1st floor windows throughout our Church and school. The cost of these projects is approx. \$400,000.00, we are only able to undertake these projects because of your support. Time and again, you respond with open hearts and remarkable generosity. Thank you for your faithful support of our parish, we are truly grateful.

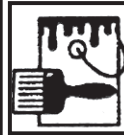
