A second collection will be taken today to support Catholic Relief Services efforts to help those who suffered such a horrible event.



Dear St. Philip Neri Family and Friends,

We give praise and thanks to God for His graces and blessings! One of the beautiful things about today's Gospel is the faith of the Canaanite woman. She comes to Jesus with a simple request: **"Lord, help me."** Her daughter is suffering, and she believes that Jesus can make a difference. At first, Jesus seems to be silent. Then, when she continues to ask, He tells her that His mission is first to the children of Israel. But the woman does not become discouraged. She continues to believe. She continues to trust. And finally, she says something remarkable: **"Please, Lord, for even the dogs eat the scraps that fall from the table of their masters."** What a beautiful image of faith. She is saying, in effect, *Lord, I know how abundant your table is. I don't need to take anything away from anyone else. I know that even the crumbs that fall from your table are enough for me.* She understood something about God that we sometimes forget: **God is abundant in His grace.** Think about a great banquet. The king's table is filled with food. There is more than enough. The table is overflowing. And even what falls from the table is valuable. The Canaanite woman had that kind of faith. She believed that even the smallest portion of God's mercy was enough to bring healing to her daughter. Jesus praises her: **"O woman, great is your faith!"** That is what Jesus is looking for from each one of us to have a heart that is open to Him, a heart that trusts Him, a heart that believes that His grace is always enough. Sometimes we come before God thinking that we have to earn His love. We think we have to be perfect before we can approach Him. We think we have to have everything together before we can ask for His grace. But the Gospel reminds us that God is not stingy with His love. God gives in abundance. His mercy is abundant. His forgiveness is abundant. His patience is abundant. His love is abundant. His grace is abundant. The question is not whether God has enough grace to give us. The question is whether we have opened our hearts enough to receive it. The Canaanite woman did not demand that Jesus give her everything. She simply trusted that even a "crumb" of His grace would be enough. How often do we need that same faith? Maybe we are carrying a problem in our family. Maybe we are worried about one of our children. Maybe we are struggling with something in our marriage. Maybe we are dealing with loneliness, disappointment, sickness, or uncertainty about the future. Sometimes we pray and say, *Lord, take this problem away.* But perhaps sometimes our prayer needs to be simpler: *Lord, just give me the grace I need for today.* The beautiful thing is that **God's grace is always enough.** We don't have to understand everything. We don't have to know what tomorrow will bring. We don't have to see the whole path ahead of us. We simply have to trust the One who is inviting us to His table. And what is that table for us as Catholics? It is especially the Eucharistic table. Every Sunday, we come to the Lord's table. And here we discover just how abundant God's love truly is. Jesus does not give us merely a crumb of His love. He gives us Himself, His Body and Blood, His very presence. Think about that. The Canaanite woman said, **"Even the crumbs would be enough."** Jesus gives us something infinitely greater: He gives us Himself. The Eucharist reminds us that God's grace is not limited. His love is not running out. His mercy is not exhausted. We come to Mass sometimes with hearts that are tired, discouraged, or burdened. But the Lord says, *Come to my table. Receive what I give you. Trust in my love.* The Canaanite woman's great faith was not that she believed she deserved God's grace. Her faith was that she knew **God was generous.** Perhaps that is the faith we need to ask for today. *Lord, help me to believe in the abundance of Your grace. Help me to trust that You have not forgotten me. Help me to open my heart so that I can receive what You want to give me.* For God's table is full of His Love and Mercy. And even what we might consider only a "crumb" of His grace is more than enough to transform our lives. So today, let us come before Jesus with the same humility and confidence as the Canaanite woman.

I pray for you every day, especially at Mass. Please pray for me.

Please invite someone to Mass today.

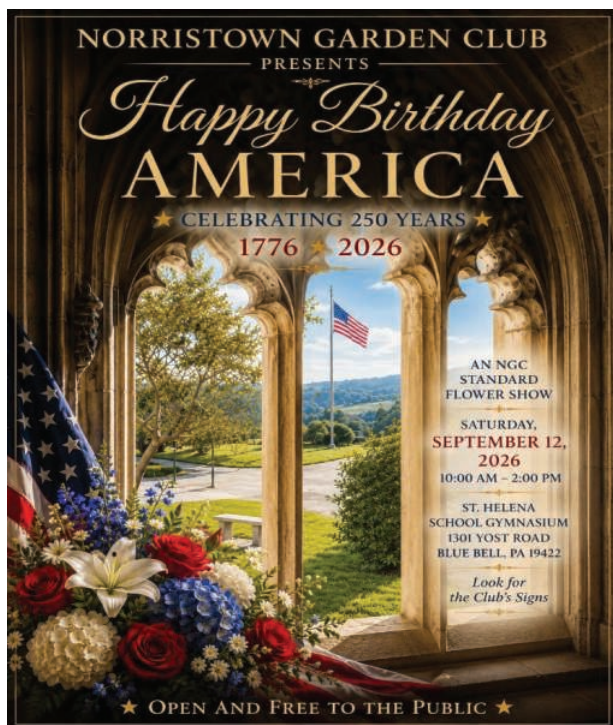

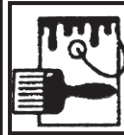
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
