Dear St. Philip Neri Family and Friends,

We give praise and thanks to God for His graces and blessings!

My brothers and sisters, one of the greatest gifts we can receive from God is His mercy. We know that we need it. We know that we have sinned. We know that there are times when we have failed God, failed others, and even failed ourselves. So, we come before the Lord and simply ask: Lord, have mercy on me. Forgive me. Help me to begin again. Psalm 103 gives us such beautiful words today: ***“Bless the Lord, O my soul... who forgives all your iniquities, who heals all your ills.”*** Then it reminds us that God is merciful and gracious, slow to anger and abounding in kindness. What a beautiful God we have! How many times have we experienced His mercy in our own lives? We have asked God to forgive us, and He does. We have come to Him with our weaknesses, our mistakes, our sins, and He does not turn us away. God’s mercy is greater than our sins. His love is greater than our failures. Because we have received that mercy, Jesus asks something difficult of us today: we must also forgive others. Peter comes to Jesus and asks, ***“Lord, if my brother sins against me, how often must I forgive? As many as seven times?”*** Peter probably thought he was being generous. Seven times seems like a lot! But Jesus responds, ***“Not seven times but seventy-seven times.”*** In other words, Jesus is telling Peter and telling us that forgiveness cannot have a limit. Now, Jesus knows that forgiveness is not always easy. Sometimes someone has hurt us deeply. Sometimes the wound is still there. Sometimes we say, Father, I want to forgive, but I just don’t know how. At times this is where we need to begin not by pretending that the hurt doesn’t exist, but by asking God for the grace to forgive. We can pray, Lord, I cannot do this by myself. You have forgiven me so many times. Please give me the grace to forgive this person. Help me to let go of my anger. Help me to let go of my resentment. Help me to see this person with Your eyes. Forgiveness does not mean that what happened was right. It does not mean that we forget the hurt or that we allow someone to continue hurting us. Forgiveness means that we place the person and the situation into the hands of God and ask Him to heal our hearts. The beautiful thing is that when we forgive, we ourselves become free. We no longer have to carry the burden of anger and resentment. We allow God’s mercy to enter more deeply into our hearts. Every time we pray the Our Father, we say, ***“Forgive us our trespasses, as we forgive those who trespass against us.”*** We are asking God to forgive us and at the same time, we are promising that we will try to forgive others. So today, let us be thankful for God’s mercy. Let us never take His forgiveness for granted. Especially, when we find it difficult to forgive someone, let us not become discouraged. Instead, let us pray for the grace to forgive. Maybe there is someone in our life today whom we need to forgive. Is there someone we need to ask forgiveness from? Perhaps we simply need to bring an old hurt before the Lord and say, Jesus, I give this to You. May we remember the words of Psalm 103: ***“He redeems your life from destruction, crowns you with kindness and compassion.”*** God has been merciful to us. God has forgiven us. God continues to love us. May we be grateful for His mercy and may we have the courage and grace to share that same mercy with one another.

I pray for you every day, especially at Mass. Please pray for me.

Please invite someone to Mass today.

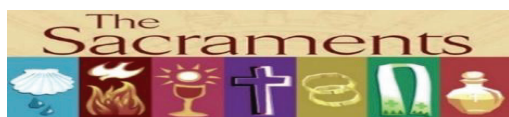
